In our backwoods adventure we begin by outlining the core skills of fire, food, shelter and water. You will learn to light fire with different techniques, including the bow drill, and using natural tinders; build and sleep in your own shelter, discuss wilderness safety and hygiene, apply natural navigational skills and learn how to source and purify water; walk through woodland identifying trees and plants that have food, medicinal and other uses.

Other topics covered include backwoods cookery, trapping and snaring, improvised weapons, river crossings, distress signals and much more.

A proven contrast comes with the addition of a High Ropes Course that is located on the heart of the Beaulieu Estate. The beauty of this impressive natural course lies in its simplicity. Using harnesses, helmets, cables, ropes and wooden beams strung 20 to 50 feet high among the trees, teams explore risk-taking, trust and coaching. Each moment is rich with discoveries, whether you're climbing, or simply encouraging “on belay.”

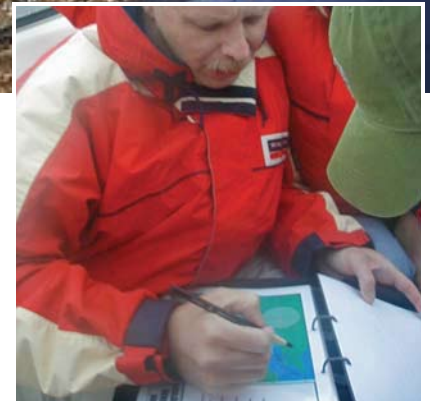
Participants walk across cable bridges, negotiate giant ladders or ride zip lines through the trees as they overcome personal fears and develop new self confidence, whilst interacting with their team mates in a very different and powerful way.

For further interest and to focus teams on the work in hand we can develop an added incentive with guests staying overnight in the wild – not entirely without creature comforts, but certainly providing a unique experience with much merriment around the campfire before bedtime. Day two dawns early for all as teams are woken to be informed that further more gruelling challenges await..... only to be whisked away for a full English breakfast and spa treatments to refresh the senses!
